Sir/Madam,

In continuation of this office's **Conditional LoP** issued to you on 15.7.2014 and with reference to letter No.F.5(5)ME/GR-1/2013 dated 7.8.2014 from Joint Secretary, Medical Education, Govt. of Rajasthan and your compliance vide letter No.F-11/RUHS-CMS/Acad./2014/2901 dated 5.8.2014 for on the above subject. I am directed to convey that the undertaking given by the Joint Secretary, Medical Education on behalf of Government of Rajasthan and the compliance report furnished by the Principal, RUHS College of Medical Sciences, Jaipur have been taken on record and the conditions attached in Conditional LoP dated 15/07/2014 are hereby withdrawn.

2. Accordingly Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur is hereby allowed to establish the new medical college, **RUHS College of Medical Sciences, Jaipur** for MBBS course with annual admission capacity of 100 seats for the academic year 2014-15 u/s 10(A) of IMC Act, 1956 and as amended from time to time.
3. This permission of the Central Government for establishment of medical college and admission of students is initially for a period of one year. It will be renewed on yearly basis on verification of achievements of annual target set out in the project report. This process of annual renewal of permission will continue till such time the establishment of medical college and expansion of hospital are completed as per the norms of Medical Council of India.
4. The college authorities may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under Section 11(2) of the IMC Act at the time of the first batch admitted against the course appears for final year examination. The Government of India reserves the right to withdraw/cancel/revoke the Letter of Permission if it comes to the notice that the permission has been obtained by misrepresentation of fact or fraud. The college authorities are bound to intimate, if any, material change in the facts based on which this permission was sought/occur.
